2013 Estate Riesling, Dreissigacker, Rheinhessen, DE <i>Owned by the same family for over 200 years, Jochen Dreissigacker farms the 21ha estate organically today. Fruit driven and surprisingly rich, with that textbook Riesling pungency.</i>	40.00
2013 Pinot Grigio, Franz Haas, Trentino Alto Adige, IT <i>To mitigate against the extreme heat - nearby Bolzano is one of Italy's hottest cities - Haas has started planting at 1000m and the step up in quality, elegance and balance is marked.</i>	43.00
2013 Sancerre, Domaine Nicolas Girard, Loire, FR <i>15ha vineyards sit on chalk, clay flint and pebbles give rise to a pristine, mineral wine with a steely spine running through which knits it beautifully together.</i>	45.00
2013 Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, Greywacke, Marlborough, NZ <i>Chief winemaker at Cloudy Bay for 25 years, Kevin Judd has been making his own stellar wines since 2009. An exotic combination of tropical fruit flavours and a hallmark herbal infusion, finishing with a zesty citrus tang.</i>	48.00

2013 Chablis 'St Martin', Domaine Laroche, Burgundy, FR <i>Domaine Laroche owns 63 hectares of Chablis vineyard on the famous Kimmeridgian soil that gives the wines such complexity. To retain purity and minerality in the finished wine.</i>	53.00
2013 Gavi di Gavi 'Montessoro', La Giustiniana, Piemonte, IT <i>In the heart of Gavi, Cortese grapes grown on the red Montessoro soils produce wines that are generously perfumed with flint and flowers with intense flavours of peach and lime.</i>	55.00
2012 Ladoix Blanc 'Bois de Mont', Domaine Chevalier, Burgundy, FR <i>Ladoix sits at the foot of the famous Corton hill. Claude Chevalier and daughters create a stunning wine of firm structure with wonderful stone fruit intensity to round the finish, along with gentle spice, butter and vanilla complexity.</i>	65.00
2007 Domaine Laroche Chablis Grand Cru 'Les Blanchots', Domaine Laroche, Burgundy, FR <i>Laroche own 4.5ha of the 12ha of this Grand Cru. The South East exposure and Kimmeridgian soil produces wines that are complex, creamy and rich with jasmine and honey notes and remarkable precision.</i>	90.00
2011 Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru 'Champ Gain', Domaine Etienne Sauzet, Burgundy, FR <i>Etienne Sauzet is arguably one of the finest Burgundy Producers. The 2011's are characterized by their purity of fruit, balance and vivacity and this wine is no exception. Powerful yet refined.</i>	110.00
2010 Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru 'Les Chenevottes', Francois Carillon, Burgundy, FR <i>Francois has taken over 5ha of the estate from his infamous father Louis and his making stellar wines in his own right using organic methods. Green apple aromas corseted by hints of roasted almond. Elegant and precise.</i>	106.00
2009 Meursault 1er Cru 'Les Perrières', David Moret, Burgundy, FR <i>Meursault has 17 Grand Crus and Les Perrieres is regarded as one of its unofficial Grand Crus. David Moret creates a wine of great concentration, wonderful minerality and mouthwatering acidity.</i>	115.00

<b>2012 Chianti Classico, Isole e Olena, Tuscany, IT</b> <i>Paolo de Marchi, owner and winemaker of this estate continues to make consistently elegant wines and this is no exception. Typical Sangiovee varietal sour cherry and red fruit character with bramble notes. The texture is supple, lithe, full of scented fruit and is given depth by a mineral vein.</i>	54.00
<b>2010 `The Tithing` McLaren Vale Grenache, Willunga 100, S AUS</b> <i>Simply stunning. Made from a selection of old vines selected from Adelaide Hills and McLaren Vale, some of which are 80 years old which contributes to the intensity and complexity. Intense cherry, strawberry lift with powerful savoury overtones put this `old vine` Grenache at the serious quality end of the spectrum.</i>	54.00
<b>2013 `Peter Max` Pinot Noir, Crystallum, Walker Bay, SA</b> <i>A boutique wine operation started in 2007 by brothers Peter-Allan and Andrew Finlayson, sons of South Africa's Pinot Noir and Chardonnay pioneer, Peter Finlayson. Situated in cool Walker Bay, this Pinot exhibits bright fruit driven intensity matched by a savoury profile and delightful floral notes.</i>	59.00
<b>2010 Gevrey-Chambertin , Domaine Dominique Gallois, Burgundy, FR</b> <i>Dominique Gallois took over this domaine from his father in 1989 and now has four hectares of vines, and is highly respected among his peers. 2010 Chevrey-Chambertin is ripe but elegant, with lovely intensity from the old vines, with concentrated berry fruit and smokey undertones.</i>	69.00
<b>2010 Amarone `Vigna Garzon`, Leonildo Pieropan, Veneto, IT</b> <i>Made of Corvina, Rondinella, Croatina, this is a highly unique example of Amarone from the Pieropan stable. Concentrated and powerful, yet with such support from the fruit and subtle pepper and sweet spice that it has an incredibly elegant finish.</i>	79.00
<b>2009 `Flaccianello della Pieve`, Fontodi, Tuscany, IT</b> <i>Made from the best grapes on the estate, this is one of the original Sangiovese Super-Tuscans. It consistently scores 100pts in Wine Specator and Wine Advocate. Enjoy one of the best vintages ever made whilst you can still get your hands on it.</i>	90.00
<b>2010 Shiraz/Viognier, Clonakilla, Canberra District, Australian Capital Territory, AUS</b> <i>Aromas of violets, rose petals, raspberries and cracked pepper</i>	95.00

## RED- SUPPLE & SILKY SMOOTH

<b>2011 `Palazzo della Torre` IGT, Allegrini, Veneto, IT</b> <i>Rather than the often astringent style, Allegrini make their Valpolicella Ripasso using 30% Amarone grapes, which gives it a luscious, dark cherry, blueberry and plum soaked texture. Fantastically poised.</i>	48.00
<b>2012 `L de Lyeth` Merlot, Lyeth, California, USA</b> <i>A cult winery in Sonoma, with Bill Arbois making wines again now as he did back in the 80's. Dried red fruits and herbs marry with delicate earthy notes and wild strawberries. Exquisitely fine tannins make this soft and approachable.</i>	37.00
<b>2011 Estate Malbec, Bodega Colomé, Salta, ARG</b> <i>Not only the oldest winery in Argentina, but the one with the highest vineyards at 3000m allowing great concentration and complexity in the grapes. Blackberries, blackcurrants and violet flavours predominate. Muscular and silky at the same time.</i>	48.00

## RED – GENEROUS, WARM AND SPICY

<b>2011 Rosso di Montalcino, Poggio San Polo, Tuscany, IT</b> <i>From 16ha of vineyard in the Eastern part of Montalcino. On the nose, aromas of small fresh berries and a trace of morello cherry mingle with hints of blackberries, black cherries, vanilla, incense and liquorice.</i>	51.00
<b>2009 Rioja Reserva, Izadi, La Rioja, SP</b> <i>From the Alavesa region and at 600m which allows greater aromatic and complex grape development. Rich aromatic intensity and a nice balance of red fruit, liquorice and spices, with hints of smoke in the background.</i>	36.00
<b>2012 Adelaide Hills Shiraz , Shaw and Smith, South AUS (IWC TROPHY)</b> <i>Bright red fruits and spice notes of dried herbs including thyme. Graphite-like earthiness contribute to a savoury core that underpins the great depth and complexity of this</i>	56.00
<b>2009 Haut-Médoc, Chateau Larose Perganson, Bordeaux, FR</b> <i>Château Larose Perganson lies in Saint-Laurent-Médoc, on the border of Pauillac and Saint-Julien, next to the Château Latour vineyards. A blend of Cabernet, Merlot and Petit Verdot with a bouquet of black berries with spicier notes and classic Cabernet graphite coming to the fore.</i>	57.00
<b>2010 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rouge, Château de Vaudieu, Southern Rhône, FR</b> <i>Owned by the Brechet Family, the vineyards about those of Chateau Rayas. The vines are between 40 and 70 years old. Enticing raspberry and cacao flavours abound followed by smoky, herbal notes.</i>	66.00
